For those that were not able to attend, please see below the minutes of the meeting.

- Commissioner Ken Russell and Jeovanny Rodriguez, CITP Director did an informational presentation of the upcoming projects at Douglas Park:
 - 1. Project consist of remediation of contaminated soil and park restoration. Park is expected to be remediated via a combination of soil removal and replacement in some areas, regrading the park in other areas; new playground, walking paths, and new community center
 - 2. This project consists of furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment for the design and construction of a new community center of approximately 6,000 SQ.FT. The building will include restrooms, homework room, multipurpose room, computer room, office
- 3. The remediation and construction of a new community center estimated cost: \$6,130,900.00
- 4. The remediation and construction is anticipated to begin Spring 2016 with a project duration of 12 months.
- 5. <u>Updates on neighborhood street projects</u>: Please see attached March 2016 CITP report
- Commissioner Francis Suarez agreed that it is a good idea to extend the route of the Coral Way trolley to SW 27 Ave and Coconut Grove Metrorail station.
- Our police officers continue patrolling 27 Terr and 31 Ave area for problems with youngsters in the area. No gang activity has been reported.
- Luisana Perez, assistant to Florida Sstate Representative Jose Javier Rodriguez <u>confirmed</u> that the <u>City of Miami and Miami Dade County approved the</u> <u>installation of a new traffic light on SW 27 Ave and SW 27 ST!</u>
